Call for Interpreters

The RID Region II conference planning committee is accepting applications for conference interpreters. Full time interpreters will receive daily rate, reimbursement for conference registration fees, \$200.00 stipend for travel and a shared hotel room. Individuals that are applying for full time positions are encouraged to register for the conference, if planning otherwise to attend. Upon being hired for a full time position, interpreters will be reimbursed for fees incurred.

Part time interpreters will receive an hourly rate, and all interpreters who work a minimum of 8 hours will receive a complimentary registration to the conference provided a registration form is completed and submitted to the interpreter coordinator by July 1, 2008. Part time interpreters will not be eligible for reimbursement for conference registration fees, transportation, and hotel room.

Requirements for Consideration

- RID Certified interpreters who have at least CI and CT, CSC, CDI, NAD level IV or V, NIC Advanced or Master, and AVLIC are given priority for selection but other certifications will be considered. **Interpreters must hold a minimum of CI, CT, NIC, to be considered.*
 - Letter of interest stating full or part-time work as well as interpreting strengths and weaknesses.
 - Resume highlighting conference and platform interpreting experience.
 - References from at least 2 of the following 3 categories:
 - Conference coordinator of event related to sign language/interpreting
 - Colleague with whom you've worked at a conference related to sign language/interpreting
 - Deaf consumer
- (categories may overlap)*
- 10 minute work product samples, of both expressive and receptive work. Can be of mock scenario but should be continuous sample (not 3 x 3 minute samples, or dialog - should reflect conference level presentation material).
 - Must provide an email address, email will be utilized for all communication.
 - All applicants are to be members in good standing with RID and will be required to adhere to the NAD/RID Code of Professional Conduct.

Compensation Packages

- Interpreters will be paid a rate of \$45.00/hr for working hours only.
- A stipend of \$200.00/max for any travel over 50 miles from the conference location.
**Mileage will be calculated at \$0.485 per mile.*
- Half of the double occupancy hotel room rate will be reimbursed for those interpreters whose working schedule requires an overnight stay.
- All interpreters who work a minimum of 8 hours will receive a complimentary registration to the conference provided a registration form is completed and submitted to the interpreter coordinator by July 1, 2008.
