## Membership Categories: Definitions and Requirements

### VOTING MEMBERSHIP:

1. Members in good standing with NCRID and RID required, and
2. Those members who pay the current dues for voting membership, and
3. Those having an active interest in supporting the purposes and activities of the Corporation.
4. Documentation of RID membership is required to accompany the membership application.

### Benefits include:

- NCRID quarterly newsletter
- E-terp notifications
- Discounted rates for local and state-wide training opportunities
- Eligibility to vote on current issues relating to NCRID business
- Eligibility for stipends to defray cost of training or testing fees
- Eligibility for Chapter scholarships

*The pro-rated fee is for those members, in good standing with RID and NCRID, **who join for the first time** during January through May of the current membership year. The discount is offered to encourage new members to join to become eligible for benefits without having to wait until May.*

### NON-VOTING MEMBERS:

1. Members in good standing with NCRID required, and
2. Those members who pay the current dues for non-voting membership, and
3. Those having an active interest in supporting the purposes and activities of the Corporation
4. Students who are currently enrolled at least part-time in an interpreting program.

- Discounted rates for local and statewide training opportunities
- Eligibility for stipends to defray cost of training or testing fees
- Eligibility for Chapter scholarships

### ORGANIZATIONAL MEMBERS:

2. Those members who pay the current dues for organizational membership, and
3. Those having an active interest in supporting the purposes and activities of the Corporation
