Workshop Description: Participants will receive an overview of the expectations and what they may experience when teaching ASL in public schools compared to teaching ASL at the college level. ASL has a long history in the post secondary level. Since ASL is becoming more accepted and public schools are beginning to offer ASL classes, teachers need to be prepared to teach in a diverse environment of high school aged students.

Presenter: Michael Lupo has 14 years of combined experience teaching ASL in public school and college. He has an MS in Deaf Education from the University of Rochester and an MS in counseling from the University of North Texas. Currently he is teaching Deaf and Hard of Hearing children K-12 ASL and other academic subjects for the Department of Defense Schools. He holds ASLTA Certification and NC Teaching License in Teaching ASL, Deaf/Hard of Hearing Children, and Social Studies K-12.
